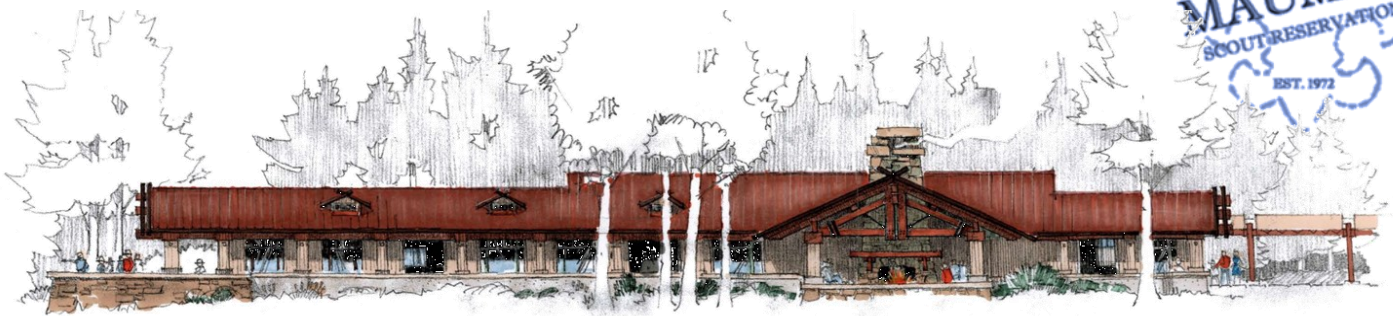

Fellowship Hall - \$3,500,000



The adventure of Maumee Scout Reservation starts through the doors of Fellowship Hall. This proposed flagship facility warmly welcomes Scouters and guests to the property, opening up new property capabilities and creating the potential for new revenue streams. Facility attributes include:

- ◇ Expanded dining area, which currently is a limiting aspect of camp session registration caps. Seating will grow from the current capacity of 230 people to 360 people. 108 seats in the HVAC controlled portion and another 252 seats in the main dining area. Generating opportunities for added revenue streams to support the camp.
- ◇ Facilities to accommodate food preparation, serving, storage, receiving, and clean-up.
- ◇ Housing for the kitchen staff, sleeping capabilities for 12 people, including shower and restroom facilities, that will be included in the lower level. 4 additional restrooms will be located on the lower level. This also opens opportunities for conferences.
- ◇ Trading Post will be relocated to this facility, presenting an expanded sales area, with 2 visitor restrooms.
- ◇ Facility will be configured so that multiple functions can occur simultaneously.
- ◇ Front of Hall will look over the Parade Field and the back deck will look over the mature woods, providing additional meeting or training space.
- ◇ Severe weather Safe Room to secure 500 people.
