

ADULT CANDIDATE RECOMMENDATION FOR THE ORDER OF THE ARROW

DEADLINE APRIL 15TH, NO SUBMISSIONS AFTER THIS DATE 21 YEARS OR OLDER

Election into the Order of the Arrow of an adult Scouter should take place only when the adult's role in Boy Scouting or Varsity Scouting will make the Order of the Arrow membership more meaningful in the lives of the youth membership. It must not be for the purpose of adult recognition or an award.

Each year, upon holding a troop or team election for youth candidates that result in at least one youth candidate being elected, the unit committee may nominate registered unit adults (age 21 or over) to the lodge adult selection committee. The number of adults nominated can be no more than one-third of the number of youth candidates elected, rounded up where the number of youth candidates is not a multiple of three. In addition to the one-third limit, the unit committee may nominate the currently-serving unit leader (but not assistant leaders), as long as he or she has served as unit leader for at least the previous 12 months.

An adult Scouter's primary registration (where they pay their membership fee) must be in the troop, team, or district/council committee that is nominating the adult.
