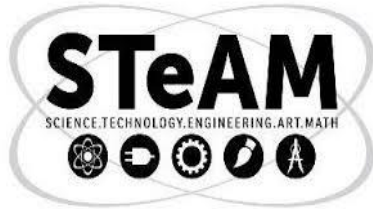




2018 Cub Scout Activity & Camping Adventures
