Campsite reservations are granted based on a first paid deposit basis. **Site deposits are \$200 per site and are non-refundable. Site deposits made by a unit before leaving camp are \$100 and non-refundable.** The unit currently in a campsite with the most paid participants has rights to reserve the site for the following year. The unit with first rights must make their site deposit prior to leaving camp to reserve with priority. The day after a camp session ends all sites not reserved are open for reservation. A site reservation does not guarantee exclusive use of a site, the camp reserves the right to assign units to campsites or adjust campsites based on the needs of the camp. Please see the payment schedule for Boy Scout Resident Camps for payment deadlines and costs. Plan ahead for camp, early bird savings are significant!

# 2018 Camp Fees - Boy Scout Resident Camps

## Massawepie Scout Camps – Camp Pioneer & Camp Babcock-Hovey

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The Early Bird Fee is earned in stages. For a Scout to qualify for early bird, a few deadlines must be met:

- **The Unit Campsite Deposit of \$200.00 (\$100 if paid at camp) is paid by 10/31/2017**
  - In order for Scouts in the unit to qualify for early bird pricing the unit deposit must be placed by the unit campsite deposit deadline.
- **\$100.00 per Scout and Adult, non-refundable, commitment is paid by March 7, 2018.**
  - Units will be responsible for a \$100 non-refundable deposit for each youth and adult committed in the online system by this deadline. Units can increase their attendance commitment based on campsite and camp availability with a \$100 deposit per spot held.
  - After the deadline, the system will calculate the total amount paid by the unit (if the unit deposit was made by 10/31/17) and divide by \$100. This will determine the number of early bird slots to be held through this phase.
    - *Example: If a unit has a 15 Scout commitment and has paid \$1,300 for camp, the unit will be awarded 13 early bird and 2 regular registration slots. ( $\$1,300/100 = 13$  early birds)*
- **Remaining Scout balances are paid by April 11, 2018. \$385.00 total per Scout, \$200 total per adult.**
  - After the deadline, the system will calculate the total amount paid by the unit (if the unit deposit was made by 10/31/17) and divide by \$385. This will determine the final number of early bird slots the unit has earned. All additional registrations will be at the regular registration rate or late registration rate based on when final payment is made.
    - *Example: If the same unit from the previous example has a 15 Scout commitment and has paid \$3,000 for camp, the unit will be awarded 7 early bird and 8 regular registration slots. ( $\$3,000/385=7$  early bird)*
    - *Example: If the same unit from the previous example has a 15 Scout commitment and has paid \$5,775 for camp, the unit will be awarded 13 early bird and 2 regular registration slots based on their deposit. The unit would owe regular registration or late registration fees for 2 of the participants. ( $\$5,775/385 = 13$  early bird)*

The following fees apply to Scouts not qualifying for early bird.

- Regular registration is \$410 per Scout if paid by May 2, 2018.
- Late registration is \$450 per Scout if paid after May 2, 2018

**Scouts that join the troop after March 7, 2018 will receive the Early Bird pricing if early bird price is paid in full by April 10, 2018. A fee adjustment form must be included with payment in order for this fee reduction to be applied.**

**Discounts:**

- Brother Discount = \$25.00 per sibling attending camp, be sure to complete the Fee Adjustment Form to receive the credit
- Second week of camp (provisional) - \$300.00 per Scout
- 1 Free Adult for every 8 Scouts that attend camp.

**Bring a Troop Bonus:** If a Troop that has not camped at Massawepie Scout Camps or Camp Babcock-Hovey in 2016 or 2017 camping season attends camp in 2018 with at least 10 Scouts, and identifies you or your Troop as a reference, your unit will receive \$200.00 in your unit account at the Scout Service Center. This excludes new units started after January 2018. Camp is more fun with friends, bring them to camp with you!

# Refund Policy

## **Initial Per-Camper Deposit:**

A \$100 per camper non-refundable deposit is due by March 7th. This initial per-camper deposit is not refundable under any circumstances.

There are situations in which a campers' fee may be refunded, either in whole or in part to the unit. Please note that checks will not be written to individual families.

## **Refunds for Extenuating Circumstances (less initial \$100 deposit):**

The complete balance of a campers' fee (less the initial deposit) may be refunded **up until two weeks prior** to the start of your week at camp for the following reasons if accompanied by appropriate documentation:

- Medical issue regarding the camper
- Summer School
- Extreme family emergencies

Refunds requested **within two weeks of camp up until the unit's billing conference at camp** can be issued. \$250 of the fees paid will be retained with the balance refunded.

**No refunds will be considered after the unit billing conference takes place at camp.**

Please be aware that Seneca Waterways Council cannot provide full refunds after this timeframe as certain expenditures have been made (e.g. food and program-related items) based upon the unit's projected attendance.
