



The National Order of the Arrow Conference (NOAC) is a week-long gathering of Arrowmen from across the country at a college campus. Activities include leadership and OA training, inspiring and spectacular shows, social gatherings, food, games, competitions, patch trading, Native America dancing shows and so much more. In 2018, NOAC will be at Indiana University, Bloomington, Indiana from July 30th to August 4th, 2018. The cost to attend this awesome event will be \$525 for the Conference fee, plus travel expenses. The fee includes five night's housing, five full days of program and training, 14 meals, program and support materials, registration materials, insurance, and recognition items during the six-day conference. An individual's final cost will be subject to fundraising participation, to be finalized as soon as possible as the conference date gets closer. This event is open to all members of the Order. We are now accepting deposits of \$100 per person wishing to attend the NOAC 2018.
