- Individual fisherman must possess their own NYS Fishing license, failure to obtain a license will
 disqualify all members of the boat from participation in the LOC Derby prizes.
- Specific charter captains may be requested and are honored on a first come first serve basis.
- A combined luncheon will take place for both groups at noon.
- A special 2 day option is available for a limited group. 2 day participants will fish Sunday August 19th and Monday August 20th. Sunday departure will be at 3:30pm
- Tipping of charter captains is appropriate based on your experience.
