



USA Archery Level 2 Instructor Course

Course Description

This course provides students with an introduction to the National Training System (NTS) Steps of Shooting for recurve and compound, equipment and accessory setup, athlete development and events as well as qualities students to teach the Level 1 Archery Instructor Certification Course. Graduates of the Level 2 Archery Instructor Certification Course are well prepared to serve as the lead instructor for long-term archery programs.

Upon successful course and exam completion you will be eligible for certification providing you meet the required prerequisites which includes becoming a member of USA Archery, submit and be approved through a USA Archery background check, and complete the USA Archery Center for Safesport training.

Course Requirements

- Participants must be at least 18 years of age or older.
- Participants must attend the entire course.
- Demonstrate practical application of range safety.
- Demonstrate ability to safely shoot a bow and arrow and teach basic archery skills.
- Pass each of the written exams with a score of 75% or higher.
- Complete and submit the **Applicant Data Form** to the course instructor for submission to USA Archery.

Participants are responsible for their own meals. Coffee, tea, and snacks will be provided. Friday and Saturday night camping are available. Contact course director Eric Falkman if you plan on arriving on Friday.
