Certified Rifle and Shotgun Instructor Classes



This course is being conducted by the Boy Scouts of America in conjunction with their National Camping School division. The primary purpose of this course is to provide individuals who plan on attending the shooting sports director section of National Camping School the opportunity to attain the required NRA rifle and shotgun instructor certification. Those individuals will have priority in terms of registration. Individuals who are not planning on attending the shooting sports director section of National Camping School may also attend this course if there is room. The maximum number of participant for the course is twenty-five individuals. Those individuals who are not planning on attending the shooting sports section of National Camping School will be notified two weeks prior to the course to let them know if they will be able to participate.

The course will include topics on rifle and shotgun knowledge, safe handling, ammunition knowledge, firing the first shots, the various positions used in rifle shooting, how to evaluate and improve the performance of beginning shooters and rifle and shotgun sports and activities. In addition, we will review how an instructor fits into the NRA basic firearm training program, using a training team to deliver the program, training materials and aids and how to use them, and the essentials of organizing a rifle or shotgun course.

Participants must have completed both the NRA basic rifle and basic shotgun courses prior to the instructor courses and bring their completion certificates in order to participate in the instructor courses. There is a live-fire qualification which will be conducted during the course. Additional information will be communicated to participants once they have registered for the course. **NO LIVE AMMUNITION OR FIREARMS SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO THE COURSE.**

In order to complete certification, applicants must participate in all required days of training, demonstrate their ability as instructors, complete and earn a 90% grade on the instructor exam and complete the instructor registration process on the NRA instructor web site. **(NOTE: Participants MUST attend all days of training, even if they already have an NRA certification.)**

Two of these courses will be offered in Area 3 of BSA's Northeast region. The dates, locations, and course directors are listed below.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION: Registration must be done through your local council. You should contact the individual who is in charge of National Camping School registrations for your council to find out the specific registration procedures.

Go to ncsbsa.org and select "Calendar" from the tabs near the top of the page. This brings up a screen listing all National Camp School courses by date, location, and specified offerings for that location. Scroll down the screen until you see "NRA Rifle and Shotgun Instructor Training". Click on that statement. This will bring up a list of only those courses. Again, you will have to contact your council's representative who is in charge of National Camping School registrations in order to register for the course.
