RULES FOR FAMILY CAMPING

1. **Between June 30th and August 3rd** all campers must check in at the Central Office with the Office Manager **before occupying the cabin or site**. Please plan your travels to arrive between 1:00 PM – 4:00 PM. At check in, you will be asked to list the name and age of each person in your group, your vehicle description and also sign a waiver of liability claims. Check out time is before 11:00 AM.
2. Occupancy of cabins, lodges, tent sites and RV sites shall be limited to the number of persons listed on the reservation sheet and the family camp permit. Occupancy is defined as using the facility for eating, sleeping or bathing. You will be assigned a camp site when you arrive.
3. Pop-up campers, RV's, and tent camping shall be in areas designated by the Camp Ranger only. **There will be NO beachfront camping due to the environmental impact on the lake.**
4. **The Dining Hall is permitted for use by reservation only.**
5. Picnic tables and other camp equipment are **not to be moved** without permission from the Camp Ranger.
6. All outdoor fires must be built in a "fire ring" (flames no higher than 24") or on a "fire alter". All fires must not be left unattended. You must have at least two #10 cans of water nearby. Firewood may be gathered. No standing trees may be cut. If conditions warrant, the Ranger may prohibit outdoor fires altogether.
7. No pets are allowed.
8. Please be considerate of your neighbors by keeping your voices and radios at a low volume. Quiet hours are from 10pm- 8am. Please do not run generators and keep noise to a minimum.
9. No firearms of any kind. Guns, air rifles, air pistols, bow & arrow, etc. are not permitted.
10. No all-terrain vehicles are permitted on the camp property.
11. New York State mandated rules concerning the use of the waterfront are posted by the entrance to that area. All campers must abide by these rules to continue enjoying the waterfront area.
12. Parking Policy: If you are using an RV or tent site, one vehicle is allowed in the site, any additional vehicles must be parked in main parking lot. Vehicles for cabins/ platform tent are limited to one vehicle per cabin. All additional vehicles must park in the main parking lot. No vehicles may drive over water lines. Do not block camp roads.
13. Cabins reservation fees are prorated by day. Cabins can also be rented for a full week session or weekends.
14. If you have a Scout who is participating in the Camp Pioneer program while you are family camping, you are permitted to visit for up to 3 days. Any visit made after the 3rd day will require registration with the Boy Scouts of America, & completion of Youth Protection Training. Visitors are required to check-in at the Camp Pioneer office before visiting their Scout or Unit. All visitors must follow the rules and regulations laid out in the Leader's Guide. Family members who would like to participate in an activity at Camp Pioneer, must provide a completed & signed copy of a BSA medical form (Parts A & B only) to the Camp Pioneer Health Officer when they check in. All activities are age appropriate for registered Scouts and Venturers, however merit badge class participation requires approval from the Camp Pioneer Program Director. Children who are 11 years old, or younger should check with the Camp Office for a list of activities that are age appropriate. Visitors who would like to eat in the Dining Hall must purchase a meal ticket. Meals tickets can be purchased at the Camp office, check the leader's Guide for price.
15. Filled trash bags must be placed in the camp dumpster daily located in the main parking lot by the office. Please tie bags shut. **Cleaning supplies and paper products are not included with cabin rentals and should be brought by the renter.**
16. The Seneca Waterways Council, BSA is pleased to make these facilities available for your enjoyment. We ask your help in keeping them in good condition. The cost of damaged camp property or destruction of grounds will be charged to the renter based on repairs needed. We ask that your conduct and behavior reflect the high standards of the Boy Scouts of America.

Please remit the reservation fee with this application. This reservation fee is applied to the rental fee. Make checks payable to: Seneca Waterways Council, Inc., BSA. Applications received without the fee will be returned. The balance of the rental fee is due **June 1, 2019** and is non-refundable after this date. **All fees are non-refundable including the reservation fee.** For questions or information, contact Camping support desk at 585-241-8545 or at camping@senecawaterways.org.

FEE STRUCTURE AND FACILITIES INFORMATION:

TENT SITES: \$35.00 per night or \$240 for one week session for up to 10 people per site. Picnic tables furnished. Water, toilet and shower house nearby.

Reservation Fee= \$35 Non-refundable

PLATFORM TENTS: \$45.00 per night (2 night minimum) or \$315 for one week session. Two person tent on platform with cots. Picnic table and water in site, toilet and shower house nearby. - * Two platform sites with canvas is available in Mountaineer Base Camp.

Reservation Fee = \$90 Non-refundable

RV SITES: \$55 per night (2 night minimum) or \$375 for one week session. One RV or tent trailer per site. Six people maximum, except one household family. No hook ups. Water, toilet and shower house nearby. Dump station available.

Reservation Fee = \$110.00 Non-refundable

CABIN TENTS: \$45 per night (2 night minimum) or \$225 for a one week session. Eight person tent on a platform with cot bunks. Picnic table and water in site, toilet and shower house nearby. Four Cabin tents available in Mountaineer with two in each site.

HEALTH LODGE: Rustic cabin with two bedrooms and a main room (sleeps six). Front porch, picnic tables and fire pit. No water in cabin, toilet, water, and shower house nearby. Some housekeeping supplies provided. Bring bedding.

Daily Rate= \$60.00/ Weekly Rate = \$400

Reservation Fee = \$120 per week Non-refundable

TRADING POST LODGE: A Large bunk room style cabin with one main bunk room and smaller separate room (sleeps twelve). Front porch, picnic tables and fire pit. No water in cabin, toilet, water, and shower house nearby. Some housekeeping supplies provided. Bring bedding.

Daily Rate= \$65.00/ Weekly Rate = \$450.00

Reservation Fee = \$130 per week Non-refundable

COOKS CABIN: This cabin is a small two bed room cabin with a small seating area, table, refrigerator and nice front porch with view of Massawepie Lake. Sleeps 3-4 people. No water in cabin, toilet, water, and shower house nearby. Some housekeeping supplies provided. Bring bedding.

Daily Rate \$50.00/ Weekly Rate = \$340.00

Reservation Fee = \$100- Non-refundable
