RULES FOR FAMILY CAMPING

1. Between **August 18th and September 2nd** all campers must check in at the Health Lodge with the Family Camping Director **before occupying the cabin or site**. Please plan your travels to arrive between 1:00 PM – 4:00 PM. At check in, you will be asked to list the name and age of each person in your group, your vehicle description and also sign a waiver of liability claims. Check out time is before noon on the last day.
2. Occupancy of cabins, lodges, tent sites and RV sites shall be limited to the number of persons listed on the reservation sheet and the family camp permit. Occupancy is defined as using the facility for eating, sleeping or bathing. Specific cabins **CANNOT** be reserved. You will be assigned a cabin when you arrive.
3. Pop-up campers, RV's, and tent camping shall be in areas designated by the Camp Ranger only. **There will be NO beachfront camping due to the environmental impact on the lake.**
4. **The Dining Hall is not permitted for use.**
5. Picnic tables and other camp equipment are **not to be moved** without permission from the Camp Ranger.
6. All outdoor fires must be built in a "fire ring" (flames no higher than 24") or on a "fire alter". Larger fires can be built at the Pioneer Campfire Circle. All fires must not be left unattended. Firewood may be gathered. No standing trees may be cut. If conditions warrant, the Ranger may prohibit outdoor fires altogether.
7. Pets are allowed but must be on a leash when outside your cabin. Dogs and cats are not permitted on the beach or in the swimming area. Noisy pets shall be removed from the reservation. All pet waste is to be disposed of properly.
8. Please be considerate of your neighbors by keeping your voices and radios at a low volume.
9. No firearms of any kind. Guns, air rifles, air pistols, bow & arrow, etc. are not permitted.
10. No all-terrain vehicles are permitted on the camp property.
11. New York State mandated rules concerning the use of the waterfront are posted by the entrance to that area. All campers must abide by these rules to continue enjoying the waterfront area.
12. Personal flotation devices (PFD's) must be worn at all times in canoes, rowboats and sailboats. This is a BSA policy and it will be enforced for your own safety.
13. When you are finished with them, all canoes must be stowed upside down on a rack. Return the oars, paddles, PFD's to their proper storage areas. Secure sailboats and rowboats to the mooring lines. Please do your part to keep the area neat and clean.
14. All canoes, rowboats and sailboats must remain on Massawepie Lake, at Pioneer Beach unless you obtain permission from the Family Camping Director for other arrangements. All boats must be returned to Pioneer Beach at the end of the day or at the end of an overnight trip.
15. Electric trolling motors are the only outboards permitted on the Lakes and Ponds of Massawepie Scout Camps.
16. Parking Policy: If you are using an RV or tent site, one vehicle is allowed in the site, any additional vehicles must be parked in main parking lot. Vehicles for Cabin Row are limited to one vehicle per cabin. All additional vehicles must park in the main parking lot. No vehicles may drive over water lines. Do not block camp roads.
17. Cabins reservation fees are not prorated by day. Cabins can be rented for a full week session or the Labor Day Weekend.
18. Filled trash bags must be placed in the camp dumpster daily. Please tie bags shut. Empty bags can be obtained at the Health Lodge. **Cleaning supplies and paper products are not included with cabin rentals and should be brought by the renter.**
19. The Seneca Waterways Council, BSA is pleased to make these facilities available for your enjoyment. We ask your help in keeping them in good condition. The cost of damaged camp property or destruction of grounds will be charged to the renter based on repairs needed. We ask that your conduct and behavior reflect the high standards of the Boy Scouts of America.

Family Camping consists of two one-week sessions and one Labor Day weekend. Sign up for one or all of the sessions. Massawepie can be your end of summer get away!

Please remit the reservation fee with this application. This reservation fee is applied to the rental fee. Make checks payable to: Seneca Waterways Council, Inc., BSA. Applications received without the fee will be returned. RESERVATION DEADLINES:

Reservations for the 2019 Family Camping Season will be accepted starting November 1, 2018 and will be limited to a maximum of two cabins and/or two sites. After April 1, 2019 additional cabins may be reserved on first come, first served basis.

FAMILY CAMPING WEEKS:

Week #1 - August 17-August 23 **Week #2** - August 24 - August 30

Labor Day Weekend - August 31 - September 2

FEE STRUCTURE AND FACILITIES INFORMATION:

TENT SITES: \$35.00 per day or \$240 for one-week session for up to 10 people per site. Picnic tables furnished. Water, toilet and shower house nearby.

Reservation Fee= \$35 Non-refundable

PLATFORM TENTS: \$45.00 per day (2-night minimum) or \$315 for one-week session. Two-person tent on platform with cots. Picnic table and water in site, toilet and shower house nearby. - * Only 1 platform site with canvas is available at Tupper Site.

Reservation Fee = \$90.00 Non-refundable

RV SITES: \$55.00 per day (2-night minimum) or \$375 for one-week session. One RV or tent trailer per site. Six people maximum, except one household family. No hook ups. Water, toilet and shower house nearby. No dump station available.

Reservation Fee = \$110.00 Non-refundable

CABINS: Specific cabins **CANNOT** be reserved. You will be reserving "1" or "2" cabins and they will be assigned at arrival based on availability. Maximum number determined by available sleeping accommodations, but usually not more than 5 per cabin. Two bedrooms, flush toilet, shower, heat (but building not winterized), living-dining-kitchen area, stove, refrigerator, basic utensils and dishes. Bring your own bedding, towels, housekeeping supplies and special cookware.

Weekly Rate = \$425.00

Labor Day Weekend Rate (Sat-Mon) = \$225.00

Reservation Fee = \$200 per week, \$100 for Labor Day Weekend - Non-refundable

VOYAGEUR LODGE: A pine paneled, winterized cabin which sleeps six (6): one double bed, 1 bunk bed and 1 single bed. Furnished same as cabins above, plus carpeting. Some housekeeping supplies provided. Bring bedding and towels.

Weekly Rate = \$450.00

Labor Day Weekend Rate (Sat-Mon) = \$250.00

Reservation Fee = \$225 per week, \$125 for Labor Day Weekend - Non-refundable

TREK LODGE: A winterized cabin suitable for non-family groups. Three bedrooms and sleeps 12. Living room-kitchen area, bathroom with shower stall and wood heat.

Weekly Rate = \$500.00

Labor Day Weekend Rate (Sat-Mon) = \$270.00

Reservation Fee = \$250 per week, \$125 for Labor Day Weekend - Non-refundable

GANNETT LODGE: This winterized building has a large dining and recreation area with fireplace, two bunk rooms each with 24 beds, men's and women's bathrooms with showers and a large well-equipped kitchen. Some housekeeping supplies are provided. Bring your own table service, bedding and towels.

Weekly Rate = \$1,000.00

Labor Day Weekend Rate (Sat-Mon) = \$600.00

Reservation Fee = \$500 per week, \$300 for Labor Day Weekend - Non-refundable
