1. Camp – De-winterize Indian pumps at Mountain Man, Walmsley Sawyer and Cub Adventure Camp latrines
2. Camp – De-winterize string trimmers and mowers that are in Vehicle Storage Building
3. Camp – De-winterize Camp water systems
4. Camp – Complete dam outflow pipe structure
5. Camp – Spread gravel on trails and paths
6. Fort & Castle - Interior painting of walls and ceiling
7. High Seas Bathroom – Installation/replacement of ceiling fans
8. Maxion Lodge – Complete polyurethane application
9. Amy Jenkins – Complete rewiring
10. Amy Jenkins – Interior painting of walls and ceiling
11. Amy Jenkins – Replace retaining wall at rear of building
12. Walmsley Sawyer – Replace and build new Shower House
13. Shop – Install a metal roof
14. Shop – Repair shop walls and install metal siding
15. Cohn Lodge – dig and install French Drainage System
16. Trading Post – Complete tongue and groove walls
