

Archery Rangemaster Training Camp Cutler Objective/Purpose

BSA Archery Rangemaster Training (CS31) is the national training outlined in the National Shooting Sports Manual. [LINK](#) This Course is required to be a qualified/trained BSA Archery Range Supervisor or Cub Scout Range Officer, and to safely operate & supervise a 'live' range within Seneca Waterways Council. Participants will be issued a Training Course Pocket Certificate, No. 33767, upon completion that needs to be renewed every two years. Trainer(s) are Certified by USA Archery & the National Field Archery Association using the most current training manual. Open to registered scouters that are 18 yrs. old or more with current Youth Protection, Weather Hazard Training, First Aid / CPR. The class usually consists of a classroom review of the material, followed by practice on the range, and should take less than 5 hours.

Many things have changed and continue to change in the Scouting Program. For Cub Scouts reference the [Cub Scout Shooting Sports Guide](#). The purpose of this program is to provide properly trained Archery Range Instructors that can oversee an archery range as outlined in the Shooting Sports Manual. The Archery program is designed to emphasize safety and marksmanship development under the direction of trained range masters using nationally approved instructional methods. The training planned for this event is tailored specifically to the Seneca Waterways Council's Camp Cutler but would qualify an instructor to oversee any BSA Property Range or specifically approved Range. Standard Operating Procedures can differ at each Range, and would need to be sought out by anyone wishing to conduct a shoot at another site/ range. Having a quantity of available trained Rangemasters in the Council is crucial to being able to put on a good shooting sports program. As a trained Rangemaster I hope you will join us for weekend, and other special Council Events to help put on an enjoyable Archery Experience for our youth.
