Scouts will be given the opportunity to show off their Scout Craft, Leadership, creativity, engineering, problem solving skills. The teams will be given seven scenario-based challenges to overcome with limited resources.

"You were excited for your trip to the northern parts of Minnesota to go camping with your scout troop, however you never made it. You were on Flight 646 which crashed in a lake surrounded by a wooded area on the vast prairies of the Northern Lights grasslands. During the crash you were able to find some supplies that you were able to carry before you jumped out of the plane. This was only the beginning of your problems. You may have survived the crash, but no flight is over till the passengers reach their designation.
