The Scholarship Program

The Matt & JoAnn Butler Youth Development Scholarship Program recognizes the importance of comprehensive youth development and the value of continued participation in the Scouting program through the Girl Scouts of the USA and the Boy Scouts of America. The Matt & JoAnn Butler Youth Development Scholarship Committee will annually select recipients to receive \$2,000 scholarships to be used for post high school education.

To ensure that your application is reviewed and processed as quickly and accurately as possible, please read and follow these procedures and requirements as written. **Failure to follow ALL the below listed requirements could result in your application being dismissed from consideration.**

PROCEDURES

The student applying for a scholarship must:

- Complete the application personally.
- **Enclose only the items requested** in the requirements (no biographies, resumes, or supplementary lists of achievements).
- **Answer all questions on the application.** (“See attached” is not an acceptable answer.)
- **Submit all supplemental information** with the application form to ensure that all items are available for review at the same time. (The Committee cannot assume responsibility for matching items that come in separately.)

- Be advised that only those **applications received by 5:00 p.m. on October 15, 2018 will be considered.** Faxes and/or Emails will not be accepted for consideration.
- Be advised that applications become the property of the selections committee and will not be returned to the applicant. By December 1, 2018, the selections committee will inform selected recipients of its decision by phone or in writing.

REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must:

- Be currently registered with the Northern Lights Council, Boy Scouts of America; Dakota Horizons Council, Girl Scouts (Northwest and Northeast Districts only). *Submit application no later than 5:00 p.m. on October 15, 2018.
- Be a graduating high school senior entering college, university or post high school technical school in the year the scholarship is awarded. Scholarships are awarded only to those applicants who graduate from high school in the calendar year in which scholarships are presented.
- Have demonstrated leadership ability in your organization and a strong record of participation in activities outside of your organization.
- **Provide a statement by the applicant clearly stating why he believes he/she needs financial aid, signed by the applicant and countersigned by the parent.
- **Attach a brief statement of up to 150 words entitled, “*What receiving this Youth Development Scholarship would mean to me.*” ****These are the only supplemental information required. Endorsements from teachers, counselors, etc., should not be included.**

Scholarship funds will be held in escrow and sent directly to the financial officer at the school of your choice. When the Escrow Release form is received by the Northern Lights Council, your scholarship funds requiring dual endorsement will be forwarded with a statement to the school’s financial officer indicating that these funds must be used as the recipient directs and may not be used to reduce the financial grants provided by the school.

If selected to receive a scholarship, recipient must attend a presentation ceremony, if requested.
