February 2nd-3rd *Klondike Derby and Zero Hero Weekend*



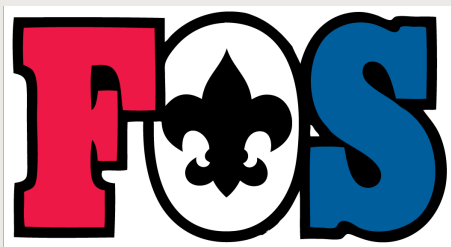

Scouting for Food

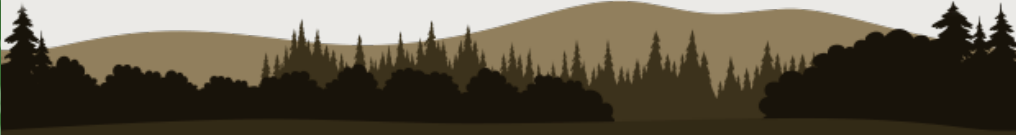
