Schedule for the day:

Registration for the baseball clinics begin at 11 am. Two baseball clinics will be run at 11:15 and 12:15, Each baseball clinic will be followed by a tentative Autograph Session with the RedHawks! Your group will be assigned to one of each of the clinics as you arrive. While your group isn't participating in the baseball clinic – you will get a chance to tour the stadium, press box and museum! This year all participants will be asked to temporarily leave the stadium by 2 pm for game setup. Gates open again at 5:00 pm. The game starts at 6:00 pm.

All Cub Scouts, Scouts, BSA, Venturers and their families are invited to enjoy an afternoon and evening of baseball with the RedHawks. Package cost is \$10 for a General Admission or you can upgrade to Reserved Seating for \$15. Cost includes ticket to the game, a RedHawks Scout Day Patch, clinic with RedHawks players for the Scouts, and a food voucher redeemable for a hot dog, chips, and drink.

Family Camp Out after the Game at Newman Field

Cub Scouts, Scouts, BSA, Venturers and Explorers can camp out on the field after the game with your family. The RedHawks staff will show a movie on the media board. After the game everyone will exit the stadium. Families that are staying overnight can get their tents, sleeping bags, snacks, etc from their vehicles and then will be allowed back into the stadium.
