## Awards Requiring District, Council or National Approval

The Council Advancement Committee is responsible for Awards and Recognition (*Guide to Advancement* 3.0.0.1 #17 & #19).

Please read the award requirements and application/nomination form thoroughly to confirm all required information is provided and the application is complete at time of submission. *Incomplete applications/nominations will not be considered and are retained for a maximum of 45 days.*

Award nominations/applications are to be submitted to the District Advancement Chair or a member of the District Key 3 for delivery to the District Advancement Chair, unless otherwise indicated on the application or below.

- Commissioner Awards should be submitted directly to the District or Council Commissioner
- Training Awards should be submitted directly to the District Training Chair

## Processing Special Awards Requiring District Approval:

### District Award of Merit

1. Presented at Annual District Recognition Dinners
  - 1.1. Unit leadership should encourage or recommend nominations for Scouters who make significant contributions at the District level.
2. Nominations are considered by a special committee appointed by the District Committee Chair. This committee recommends the recipients to the Scout Executive for approval by the Council Executive Committee.
3. Submit complete nomination form to District special committee via local district practice prior to the annual deadline (typically late winter/early spring).

### Other Awards Requiring District Approval

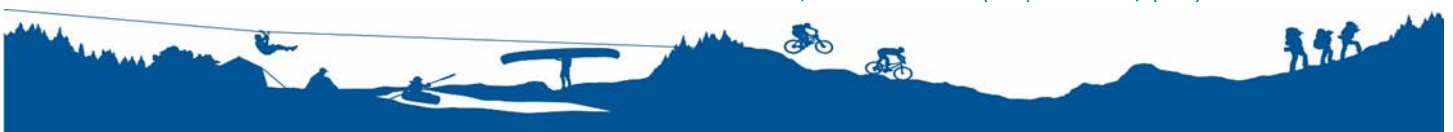
1. Submit complete nomination/application to District Advancement Chair or a member of the District Key 3 for delivery to the District Advancement Chair (unless indicated otherwise on the application).
2. District Advancement Chair will review and recommend appropriate review process for approval.

## Processing Special Awards Requiring Council Approval:

### Silver Beaver Award

1. Presented at Annual Council Recognition Dinner
  - 1.1. District Committees should encourage or recommend nominations for Scouters who make significant contributions at the Council level.
2. Nominations are considered by a special committee appointed by the Scout Executive. The committee recommends the recipients to the Scout Executive for approval by the Council Executive Committee.
3. Submit complete nomination form to Council by annual deadline (typically in early/mid-January).

### Meritorious Action Award: Medal of Merit

- Submit complete nomination to your District Advancement Chair, or a member of the District Key 3 for delivery to the District Advancement Chair, who will present to the Council Advancement sub-Committee to review for approval.
- The Medal of Merit may be awarded by the local Council after notifying the National Court of Honor.

### Other Awards Requiring Council Approval

1. Submit complete nomination/application to your District Advancement Chair, or a member of the District Key 3 for delivery to the District Advancement Chair (unless indicated otherwise on the application).
2. District Advancement Chair will review and consult as needed with Council Advancement Committee Chair and/or Scout Executive to recommend appropriate review process for approval.

### **Processing Awards Requiring National Approval:**

#### Eagle Scout

- Please see separate Council Advancement Committee process guidance.
- Submit completed application directly to Registrar.

#### Venturing Summit Award

- Please review *Guide to Advancement* 8.0.7.0 and contact Council Advancement Committee, Venturing Awards Coordinator prior to Board of Review.
- Submit completed application directly to Registrar.

#### William T. Hornaday Awards

- Please contact your District Advancement Chair to arrange for a designee appointed by the Council Advancement Committee to serve on the ad hoc sub-committee for review, in lieu of a Council Conservation Committee review.
- Submit completed application package directly to Registrar.

#### Lifesaving and National Certificate of Merit Awards

- Submit complete nomination to your District Advancement Chair, or a member of the District Key 3 for delivery to the District Advancement Chair, who will present to a Council Advancement sub-Committee to review for initial approval.
- Lifesaving and National Certificate of Merit Awards must be forwarded to the National Court of Honor to review for final approval.

#### Other Awards Requiring National Approval

- Please discuss with your District Director and/or Council Advancement Chair and/or Scout Executive to determine the appropriate submission and review process.
