MEALS AND FOOD

Camp Indian Trails has a full service dining facility. All menu options offered at Camp Indian Trails are approved by a licensed dietitian and prepared according to state food safety standards. All meals at CIT are served family style. Lunch will be served on each day of Day Camp.

If you have any medical dietary restrictions, please communicate them to the Camp Director, no less than two weeks before your session.

Day Camp Held at Token Creek:
 Meals are not provided at the Token Creek Day Camp. Please bring a lunch each day. As a courtesy to those with nut allergies and other food allergies, please consider the contents of the lunch carefully.



LEADERSHIP

Packs must provide a minimum of 2 leaders. The only exception to this rule is if a parent wishes to attend camp with a Scout individually. Siblings are allowed to attend camp with family members. Lions and Tigers must attend camp with thier parent partner. Camp recommends maintaining a 1:4 ratio where possible.



CHECK-IN

Check-in for Day Camp begins at 8 am each day and the Opening Ceremony begins at 8:45 am. Program begins at 9 am and concludes at 4 pm daily. Check-in on Day One may take more time. To facilitate this process, we encourage Unit Leaders to take attendance and then check-in the entire unit at the registration table. This is also the best method at the time of check-out. Individual Scouts registered should check-in with the parent or guardian that is also attending the Day Camp at registration table.
