It is our aim at the Glacier's Edge Council and Ed Bryant Scout Reservation to maintain a high level of safety and assurance during these trying times that are impacting our council, camp, and nation. Below we have listed those who fall into the high-risk category for COVID-19 as outlined by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) as of the date of publication (6/14/2020) of this document. We also list the symptoms that are most associated with COVID-19 as well to best inform our units who plan to camp with us. There is an inherent risk that comes with summer camp every season, this season is special in the risks we have to manager. Complying with CDC recommendations to increase sanitation, reducing community sizes, and augmenting our program have helped pave the way towards a successful and safe 2020 season.

### High-Risk Categories

- People 65 years and older
- People who live in a nursing home or long-term care facility
- People with chronic lung disease
- People who have serious heart conditions
- People who are immunocompromised
  - o People who have undergone cancer treatment recently, bone marrow or organ transplantation.
- People with severe obesity
- People with diabetes
- People with chronic kidney or liver disease

### Symptoms of COVID-19

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
