

What to Bring to Camp When You are on Camp Staff:

Clothes:

Scout Field Uniform Shirt, Scout Pants, Scout Socks (Bring a few pairs) and Scout Belt
Class B Uniform (Scouting shirts) and EBSR Polos if you have them from last year

Scout appropriate Casual Clothes

Rain Gear

Jackets/Sweatshirts (Preferably from scouting or without any other logos)

Swimsuit, Goggles, Beach towel

Shower towels, Shower Caddy (optional and recommended)

Hiking Shoes and Comfortable Shoes

Scout Hats (Optional, but stylish)

Toiletries:

Prescription Medication (If under 18, speak to the health officer when you arrive).

Aspirin/Tylenol/Band-Aids

Masks (Bring a few in case you lose one or you need to clean them)

Aloe Vera (or any kind of lotion)

Hand Sanitizer

Soap

Deodorant

Laundry detergent

Toothbrush and Toothpaste (Mouthwash if you want)

Outdoor supplies:

Hammock

Bug Spray

Sun Screen

Water Bottle (Hydrate or Diedrate)

Cabin:

Bed sheets/Blankets/Sleeping Bag (It can get pretty chilly sometimes)

Fans (It can also get pretty hot sometimes)

Phone/Phone Charger (Very Handy Alarm Clock)

Alarm clock (If you prefer not to use your phone)

Miscellaneous:

Copies of paperwork (Paperwork mishaps happen, bring copies of everything to camp just in case).
