District Advancement Committee Chair Roles & Responsibilities:

1. Serve as a resource on advancement for Unit Leadership [Unit Leaders and Unit Advancement Coordinators (Scouts BSA) or Chairs (Cub Scouts)].
2. Review monthly District Advancement Report and provide input to or follow-up with Unit Commissioners and/or Unit Leadership.
3. Attend monthly District Committee meetings and represent the District at monthly Council Advancement Committee meetings.
 - a. Support advancement-related activities for District and Council Program events and activities as required.
 - b. Support advancement-related training for District and Council events and activities as required.
 - c. Participate in review of award applications, time extensions, appeals, etc., and develop advancement resources (procedures, policies, training, programs, etc.) as required.
4. Review/Approve Merit Badge Counselors for the District on behalf of the Council Advancement Committee.
 - a. Review Merit Badge Counselors for Merit Badges requiring Special Certifications to maintain compliance with Council and BSA risk-management requirements.
 - b. Review and support the Summer Camp Merit Badge program.
5. Ensure each Unit in the District has an assigned District/Council Eagle Representative to review/approve Eagle Project Proposals and represent the Council at Eagle Boards of Review.
 - a. Maintain a succession plan for District/Council Eagle Representatives.
6. Investigate Eagle Extension proposals from all District Units in collaboration with the Assigned District/Council Eagle Representative and represent findings to the Council Advancement Committee for Review/Recommendation.
7. Promote awareness of advancement-related elements in the District including:
 - a. Advancement Resources (www.glaciersedge.org/advancement)
 - b. Religious Emblems
 - c. STEM/Nova
 - d. Youth and Adult recognition awards
 - e. Conservation awards
