The Rainbow Council George S. McGee Scout Service Center and Scout Shop will be closed Monday, May 29th, 2017 in observance of Memorial Day.

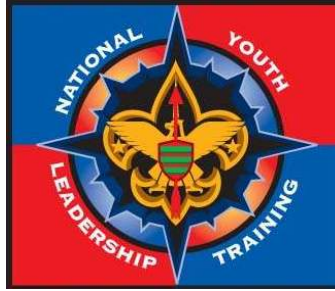
